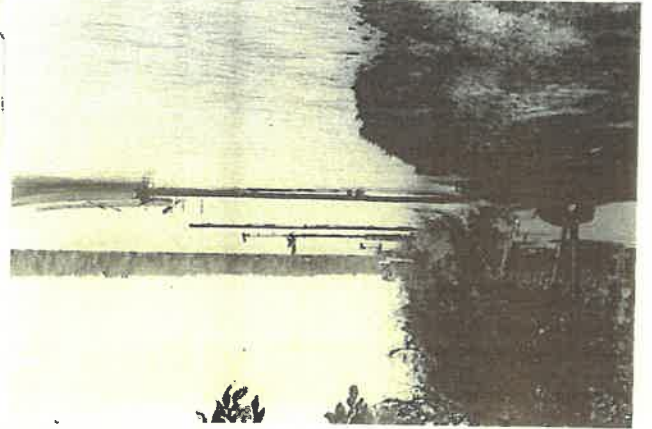
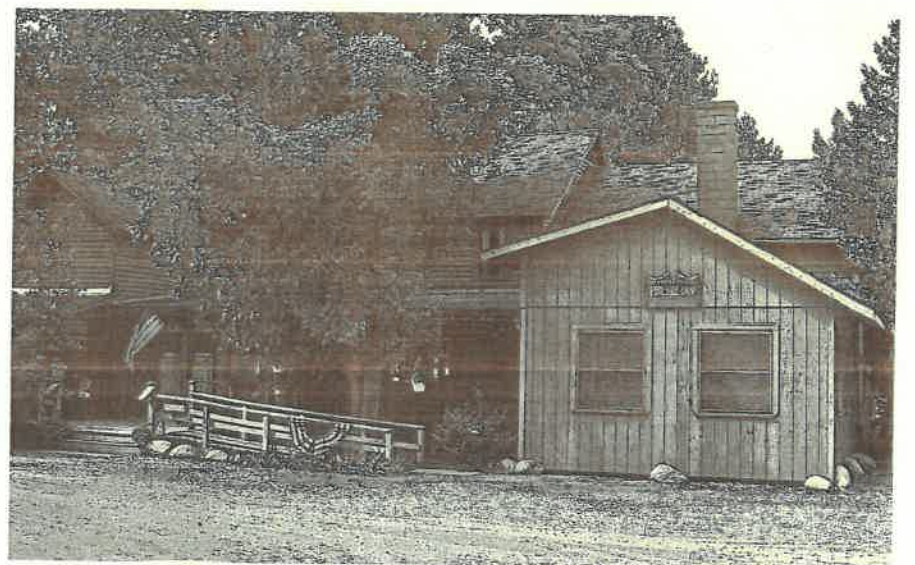


THE NORTHERN CLIMATE, and clear air of Fireside usually provides quick relief of those suffering from asthma and/or hay fever. Although the days are generally warm and sunny, the nights are usually cool. A sweater or jacket for evening is suggested.



FOR THOSE WHO ENJOY FISHING OR BOATING, there is a great variety of opportunity and scenery. The waters of Grand Lake and wooded shorelines give hint of the Perch, Rock Bass, Small-Mouth Bass, Walleyes, Tiger Muskies and Northern Pike. Panfish are usually easy to catch and plentiful (when they are biting, as they usually are) while the bigger fish will challenge even the most experienced fishermen. Catching nice walleyes is not usually too difficult, while bass and pike reward the persevering. The best time for small-mouth bass is late June, early July, or September and early October. Walleye fishing is good from June thru September, Perch, Rock-Bass, and Sunfish bite almost anytime. Fishing is fishing no matter where you try your luck, and Grand Lake is as good as any lake in Michigan, and often better. Please bring your own boat and use our convenient boat launching facilities.

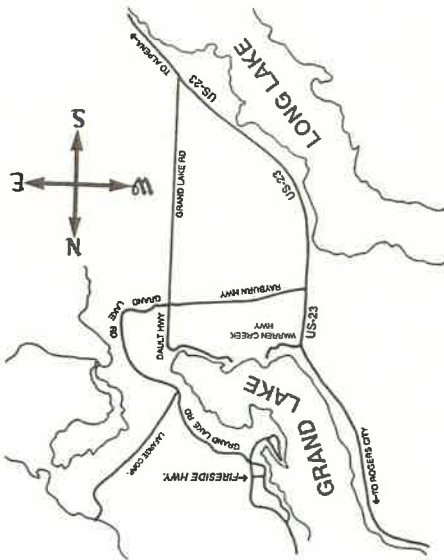

TO DRIVE TO FIRESIDE INN from Alpena, travel North on U.S. 23 (approximately 10 miles) until you come to the Grand Lake Rd. (indicated on large state sign). Turn right. Drive approximately 4 miles to stop sign. Turn right at stop sign, which is the Grand Lake Rd. Follow winding road (about 4 miles) until you come to the Fireside Inn sign (which will be on the left). Turn left on Fireside Highway and proceed 1/4 mile to the Inn.

DRIVE JUST 18 MILES north of historic Alpena, over good roads, to home-like Fireside Inn. Your last miles will be on a winding road thru dense forests of pine, birch and balsam, giving hint of the joys to come. The clear sky, the thirty-odd-mile mostly wooded shoreline, and the nineteen islands of Grand Lake provide an endless variety of scenery for people on the water. Occasionally a deer, an otter, or even a bear might be seen along the shoreline.

When you arrive at the spacious Fireside Inn grounds, you will see the big rambling Inn, and before you will be the shimmering 5,660-acre Grand Lake. Here and there, over the grounds, will be cabins of various sizes. As you step into the Inn, the rustic but comfortable surrounding will make you feel at ease. (There is nothing imitative about Fireside Inn — it is genuine, and has been here for a long time.) A pot of coffee is almost always brewing; typical of our informal atmosphere at Fireside Inn. It is safe and wholesome for children, relaxing for parents and other guests. Automobile traffic is not a hazard, since Fireside Inn has its own semiprivate roadway, Fireside Highway.

Whether you choose to occupy sleeping rooms along the spacious veranda, one of the cabins, or one of the upstairs sleeping rooms, you will find them clean and comfortable. Our staff is here to serve you and make your stay with us a very enjoyable and memorable visit.

AFTER GETTING SETTLED in your quarters, you may choose to walk along Fireside's 700-foot shoreline. Our beach is safe for children, since the lake bottom slopes gradually, without drop-offs or current. A diving raft is

anchored off-shore for deep-water swimmers. A mile and a half to the westward is the opposite shore, and to the right it stretches for several miles beyond Brown Island.

DINING AT FIRESIDE INN is on the American Plan, and is included in our offering. Meals are good and plentiful, with a different menu each day. When the dinner bell sounds, guests find a steaming repast waiting to renew their vigor.

FOR THOSE ASHORE, Fireside has tennis, volleyball, ping-pong, horseshoes, shuffleboard, etc. There are swings for the little folks. And there is forest, with trails, or one can strike off thru the brush. Many kinds of trees, shrubs, and flowers delight even the experienced woodsman. Located not far from the main building is the Teen Hut, where you may play ping-pong, and adults may visit if they wish. Easy motoring takes one to the golf courses near Alpena and Rogers City. Or, the historic lighthouses, the limestone quarries, or the sandy beaches of Lake Huron. Or enjoy our own 9 hole Disc Golf Course. All ages can enjoy this unique game that winds through the grounds of the Inn.



SLEEPING CABINS are of log and frame structure, well located in regard to the lake front and so placed that privacy is assured. The smaller cabins have one room and bath; others have living room, bedroom and bath. All but three have fireplaces and are comfortably furnished to accommodate from two to eight people. All cabins have refrigerators.

HOUSEKEEPING COTTAGES, completely furnished, each have living room with fireplace, kitchen with electric stove, refrigerator, and 2 or 3 bedrooms and bath. All dishes, bed linens and blankets are furnished.

THE SLEEPING ROOMS are in -a wing of the main building on the ground floor and open directly on to a wide porch, which is 216 ft long, facing the lake plus upstairs rooms near two complete baths. In the living room of the Inn a rustic stone fireplace with its crackling log fire adds cheer to cool evenings.

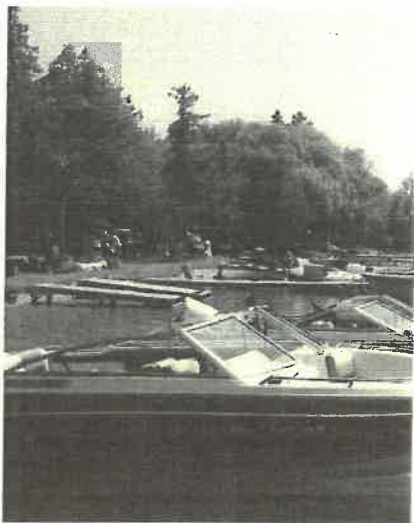

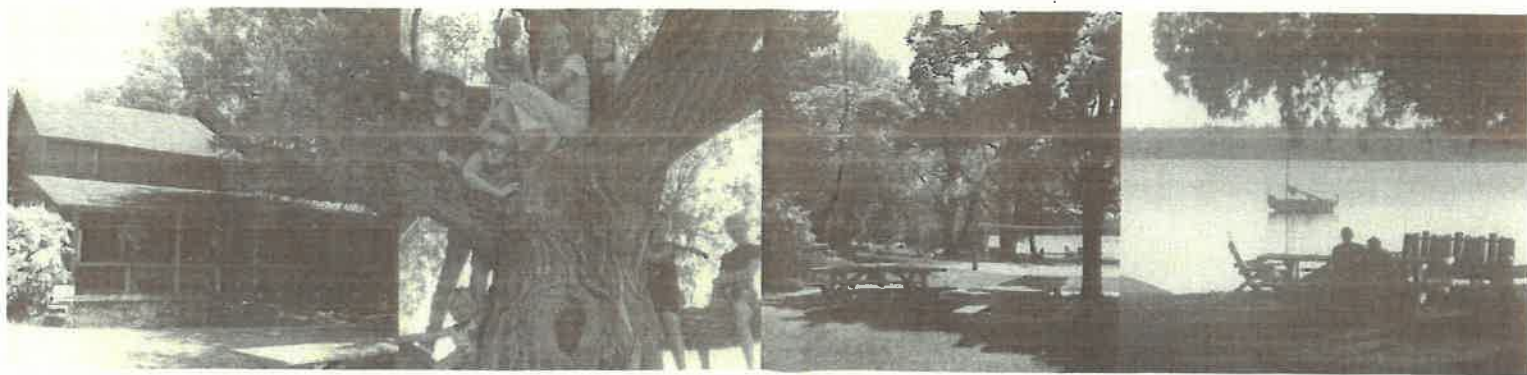
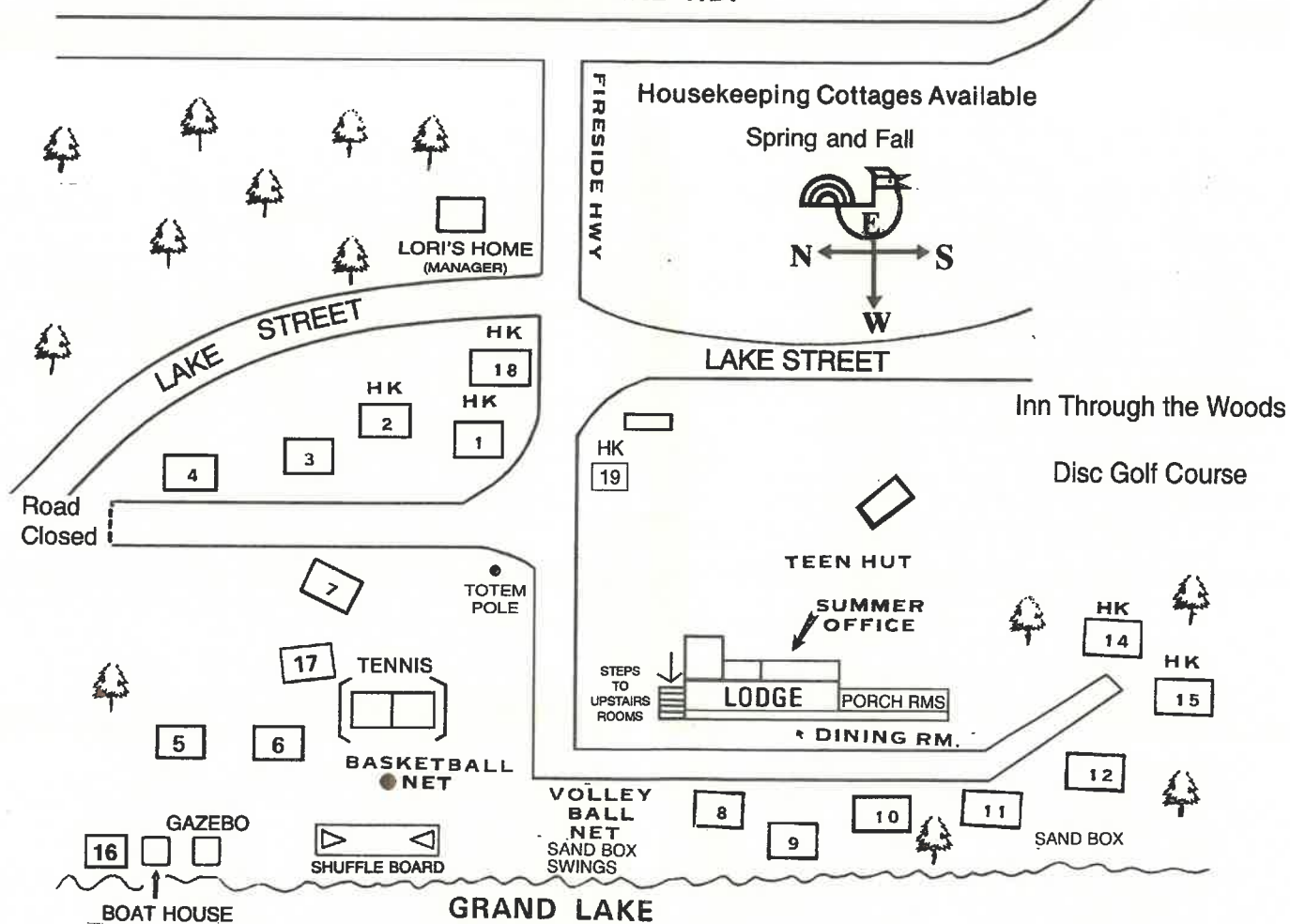
